Kentucky Employees Charitable Campaign

If you are a state employee, you can contribute to the Humane Society by having a deduction taken from your paycheck each pay period. The KECC is the annual workplace giving campaign for employees of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. You can choose from the ones they have listed on their website, or you can choose to donate to any organization you want to, besides what they have listed. The way you do this is by writing in under "Other" on the KECC form the name and address of the organization you would want your contribution to go to, and they will deduct it from your paycheck and send it to the charity of your choice. 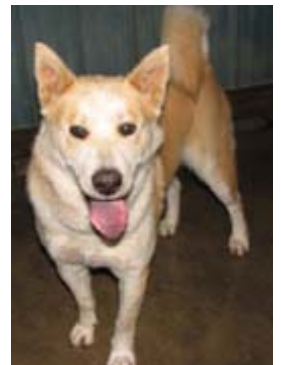


#79 Damian-Sponsored (Domestic Short Hair-white)

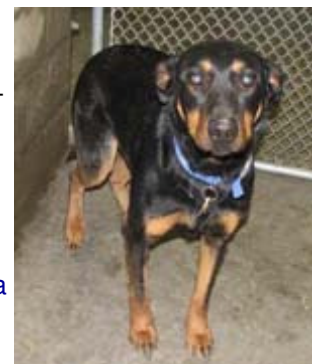


#295 Vinnie-Sponsored (Domestic Short Hair-mitted)

*Did you know that...Yearly, over 500 million ink jet cartridges are sold in the United States. Every year over 400 million cartridges, with combined weight of 200 million pounds, are discarded into our nation's landfills. The plastic used in a typical ink jet or laser cartridge takes **1,000 years to decompose**. What happens to our trash? According to the EPA, 67% of it is sent to landfills, 15% is incinerated and **less than 18% is recycled**.*
